### What is the CSU?

The Capilano Students' Union (CSU) is the student society at Capilano University that represents over 6,500 students at the North Vancouver, Sechelt, and Squamish campuses, and abroad.

The CSU provides services, including the U-Pass BC and CSU health and dental plan; supplies resources to clubs and organizations on campus; and hosts a variety of events throughout each year.

In addition to delivering services to students, the CSU is an advocate of students' interests, and ensures the needs of students are presented for consideration by the University administration and the federal, provincial, and municipal governments

### Responsibilities:

- Work towards implementing the strategic plan
- Attend and participate fully at bi-weekly board meetings
- Provide either individually or collaboratively, a written report to the board of directors at least once per month
- Attend as a voting member, all meetings of the standing committee on University Relations
- Be responsible for keeping the board informed of the activities and concerns of the members belonging to their respective faculties
- Perform such other duties as may be assigned by the board of directors
- Come prepared to meetings by reading all agenda items and attached document ahead of time
- About 2-4 hours per week
