

The following motions have been recommended by the CSU Board of Directors for consideration at the semi-annual general meeting:

MOTION 1 — Mature and parent students liaison position

Recommended Motion

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Mature and Parent Students Liaison position be created and that the following bylaw changes be approved:

BYLAW VI - BOARD, Section 1b be amended to add a new subsection (vii) reading:

“the Mature and Parent Students Liaison;”

BYLAW XIII - DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF COLLECTIVE COORDINATORS, LIAISONS, REGIONAL CAMPUSES AND FACULTY REPRESENTATIVES

Be amended to add article 7:

The Mature and Parent Students Liaison shall

- a. chair and coordinate the meetings and activities of their collective;**
- b. be responsible for keeping the Board of Directors informed of issues concerning self-identified mature and parent members of the Society;**
- c. co-ordinate campaigns and events which promote the equality and the elimination of oppression of self-identified mature students as well as advocating for and supporting student parents; and**
- d. shall perform such other duties as may be assigned by the Board.”**

And that all following articles in this section be renumbered.

MOTION 2 — Election eligibility for university senators

Recommended Motion

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the following bylaw changes be approved:

BYLAW VII - BOARD ELECTIONS (section 14) be amended to strike University Senate.

14. No member of the Society may stand as a candidate for more than one (1) elected position in any General Election or by-election. Student representatives on the ~~University Senate and the~~ University Board of Governors, who hold office as student representatives pursuant to the *University Act*, may not stand as a candidate for election to any seat on the Executive Committee.
