Election Administrator's Decision

Decision# 2023/B/4

The attached complaint was received as timely and met the requirements of an official complaint under the CSU regulations.

The complainant submitted photographic evidence that Gurjot Singh's campaign poster was placed over other candidate posters on a university bulletin board.

All candidates, including Mr. Singh were told at the candidate orientation not to cover up other posters or materials on bulletin boards with their campaign posters. Although Mr. Singh's poster is only partially covering the other posters, he still is in violation of the rule. I hereby order Mr. Singh to remove the offending poster immediately and warn him that any similar violations in this or any future election campaigns will be met with stronger sanctions, possibly including prohibition on the use of posters and disqualification.

The respondent has 48 hours from the time they receive this decision to submit an appeal in the manner set forth in CSU Procedure BD-06.1.

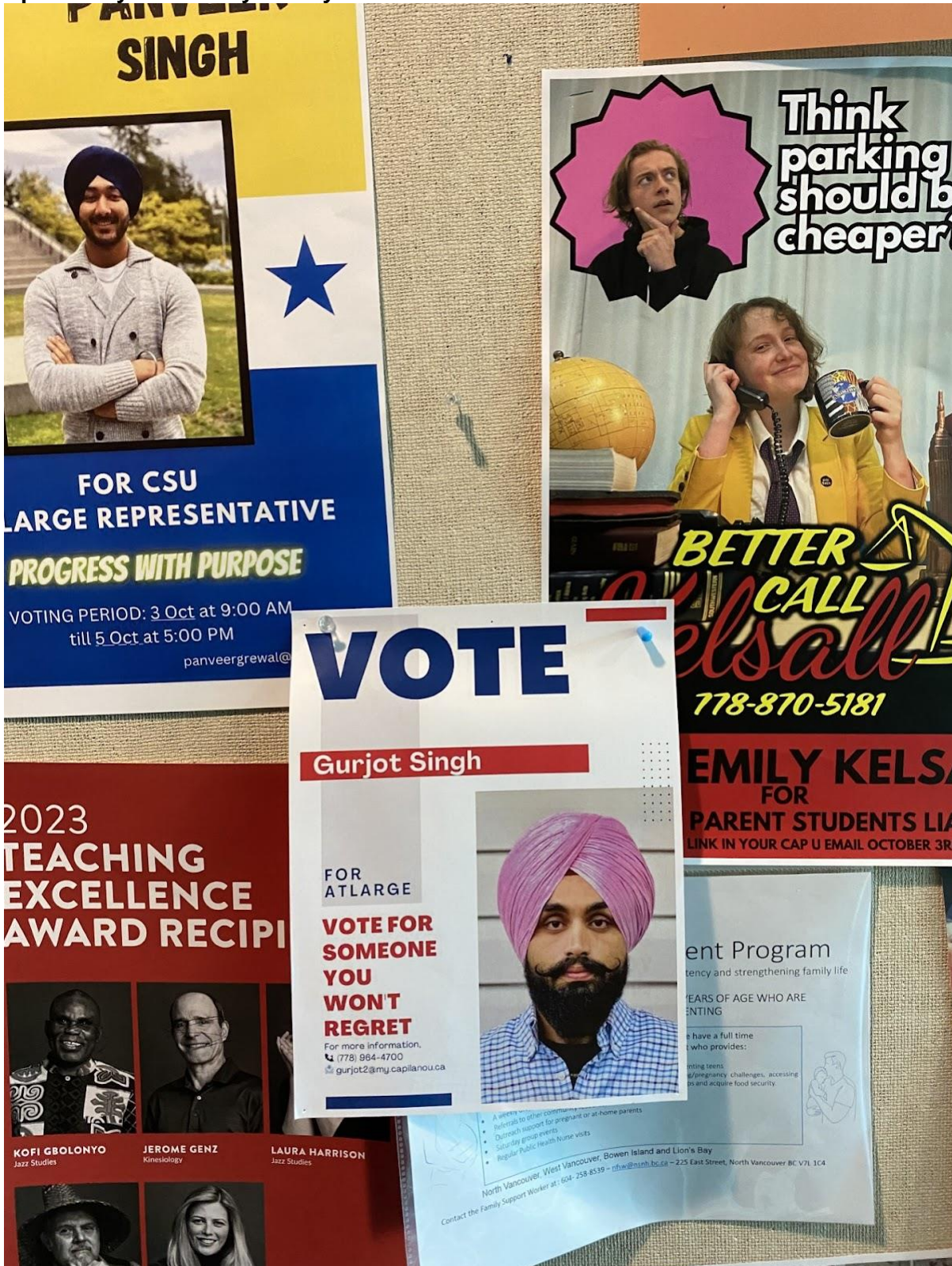
