Election Administrator's Decision

Decision# 2023/B/19

I received a complaint that met the requirements of an official complaint under the CSU regulations from a student who wishes to remain anonymous.

The complainant alleges that he overheard candidate Amritpal Singh approach his friend while he was walking between the Cedar and Birch buildings and rudely and aggressively demanded that he vote for Amritpal then and there. The complainant said that the friend did not feel comfortable coming forward with this story.

While the allegation is a serious one, the complainant has not provided enough evidence to establish that a violation occurred. In this regard it is relevant that the person who Amritpal allegedly spoke to was not willing to come forward, that the complainant was anonymous, and that there were no other witnesses.

The complaint is dismissed.

The complainant has 48 hours from the time they receive this decision to submit an appeal in the manner set forth in CSU Procedure BD-06.1.
