Election Administrator's Decision

Decision# 2023/B/5

The attached complaint was received as timely and met the requirements of an official complaint under the CSU regulations.

The complainant submitted photographic evidence that posters of candidate Shourya Sharma had been left outside in the bushes and on walkways around campus.

I contacted the candidate and asked if he had left posters outside. He said that he had been handing out the papers in question as flyers to passersby. He suggested that some of these people dropped their flyers outside rather than recycling them.

CSU Procedure BD-06.1 (at page 6-7) and the candidate handbook explicitly allow candidates to campaign using leaflets and handbills such as those found by the complainant. I have no reason to doubt the candidates version of events. That being the case, there is not enough evidence to establish that a violation has occurred and the complaint is dismissed.

The complainant has 48 hours from the time they receive this decision to submit an appeal in the manner set forth in CSU Procedure BD-06.1.






